## "Let Go and Let God.."

"Who here has been uncomfortable and afraid of doing different forms of ministry?" We all raise our hands. I agree. Who wants to be rejected?! No one. It's not natural to ask strangers if they would like prayer for their broken arm. Or it can be very uncomfortable to walk up to someone you believe God has led you to, and share an encouraging word with them. You're not abnormal because that stuff freaks you out.

The Lord is teaching me to "Let go and Let God." -- God has been revealing many areas of fear within me. As I'm recognizing these ugly traits, our Father patiently and gently reminds me, "Let go of it and let me replace it with what is right, good and true." As a result, I've taken the advice and I'll let you know it hurts when you let go of your pride and/or fear, but it's worth it! Excitingly, God has been faithful to replace the areas where

pride or fear once dwelt, with love, a sound mind, and freedom. In those times of being released, God has shown me this is what it takes for Him to work through us. It is in our submission to him, our letting go of fear, pride, or what have you, that He can move in. *It is in surrendering when ministry happens. That is how lives are transformed.* When people see you, they understand you're different and when you talk they hear you're different. You may never have to say a "very spiritual" thing but always remember that when you *let go and let God*, it is He who completes the ministry through you. You do not have to create a spiritual testimony.
